



DEMAREST NATURE CENTER ASSOCIATION ENVIRONMENTAL STUDIES SCHOLARSHIP

The Demarest Nature Center Association is offering a \$1000 scholarship to assist a graduating senior pursuing a study of, or related to, the environment.

The requirements are:

The applicant must be a high school senior attending either Northern Valley Regional High School in Demarest, The Academy of the Holy Angels in Demarest or a child of a current member of the Demarest Nature Center graduating from another high school.

The applicant must be planning to attend an educational institution in the coming school year (2010/2011) pursuing environmental studies or a similar program such as one involving habitat conservation, natural resource management, preservation and protection of nature and/or education of the public concerning such subjects.

Applications should include:

1. The student's name and complete contact information.
2. The name of the high school and guidance counselor contact information.
3. A copy of the student's current high school transcripts.
4. A copy of the Letter of Acceptance from the college or university where the applicant will be (or is considering) attending classes for the fall semester.
5. A 150 word essay (written by the applicant) discussing the reasons why he or she should receive the Scholarship.

Applications should be postmarked no later than **MAY 1, 2010** and mailed to:
